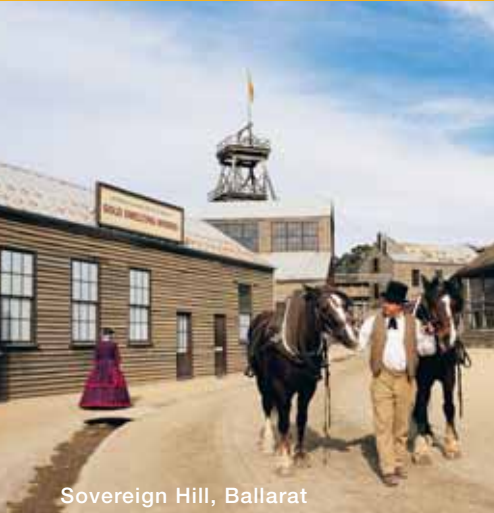

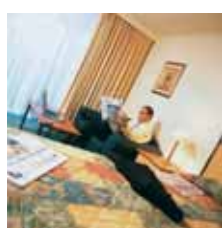
Must See & Do

Ideally situated onsite at the Sovereign Hill Township in Ballarat, an 80 minute drive from Melbourne. The Lodge is within close proximity of all of Ballarat's attractions.

Strike gold at Sovereign Hill, a living outdoor museum which recreates Ballarat's first ten years after the discovery of gold in 1851 when thousands of international fortune hunters rushed to the Australian goldfields in search of riches. It's just like stepping back in time! Pan for real gold and see a spectacular gold pour. Venture underground on a gold mine tour, catch a horse drawn Cobb & Co coach ride, view the steam driven machinery and tour the Township and Diggings.

There are over 60 working shops and buildings to explore, including hotels, schools, a theatre, crafts, a candlemaker, wheelwright and confectioner.
